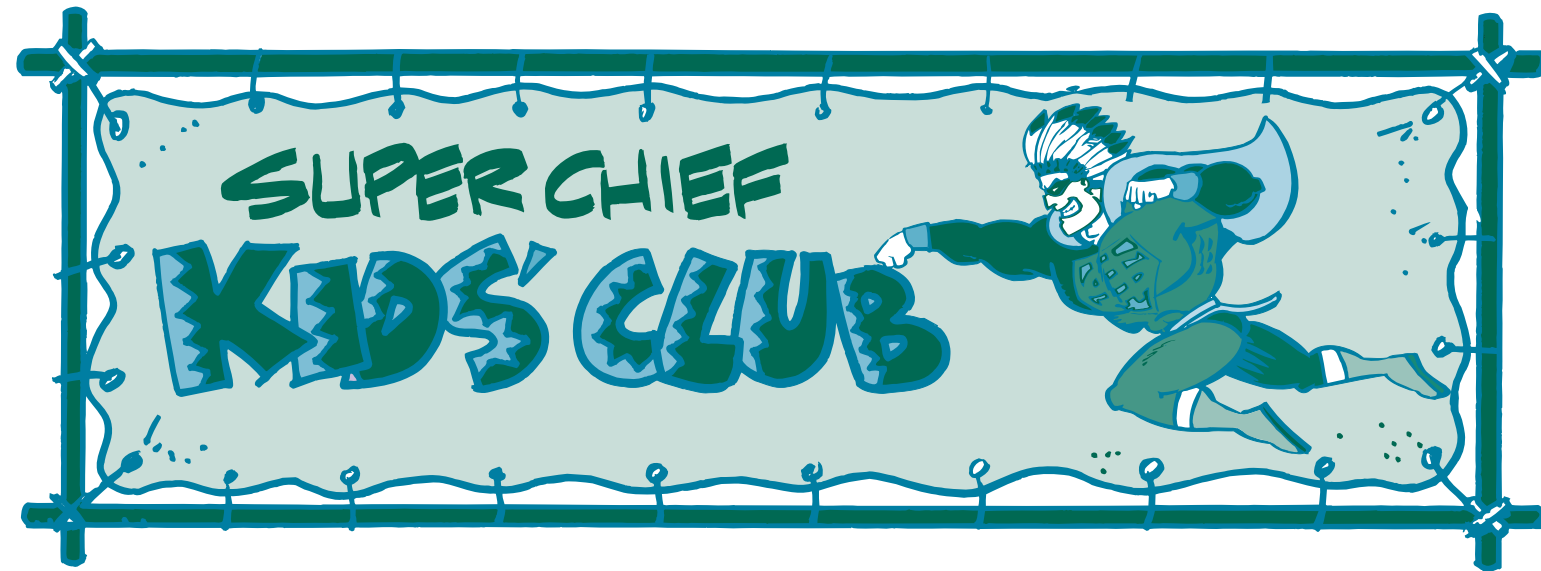

THE HISTORY OF MEMORIAL DAY

**Memorial Day will be celebrated
on Monday, May 28th this year.**

It's a popular holiday because most people have the day off school or work and can enjoy time with family and friends.



But do you know the history of Memorial Day?

Memorial Day was originally called Decoration Day.

Decoration Day was first celebrated on May 30, 1868. People originally marked this day to

honor fallen soldiers by placing flowers on graves at Arlington National Cemetery.

Today, the heritage and original sentiment of the holiday are not recognized as much as they were long ago. But in December 2000 the National Moment of Remembrance Resolution passed. This resolution asks that Americans, at 3 p.m. on Memorial Day, "voluntarily and informally observe in their own way a moment of remembrance and respect, pausing from whatever they are doing for a moment of silence or listening to Taps."

We hope that kids and adults alike will take a special moment to think about the true meaning of Memorial Day, which celebrates and honors the bravery of soldiers who have fought for our country.
